

**Supplementary Admissions Exercise for International Students
INTERNET SYSTEM
(S-AEIS-IS)
Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)**

Q1. Who should take part in the S-AEIS?

International students (i.e. non-Singapore Citizens/Singapore Permanent Residents) who do not have a place in a local school and who wish to seek admission to mainstream primary schools and secondary schools at the **Primary 2-4 and Secondary 1-2** levels in Apr/May of the current academic year are eligible to take part in the S-AEIS.

Q2. What is S-AEIS-IS?

S-AEIS-IS serves as an online channel to access the outcome of application for school admission via the S-AEIS. With the internet system, S-AEIS applicants can now retrieve the application outcome from a computer with internet connection.

Q3. Where can I access the S-AEIS-IS?

You can access the S-AEIS-IS from a computer with Internet connection.

Q4. When can I access the S-AEIS-IS?

The S-AEIS-IS will be accessible 24 hours during the following period:

Q5. How do I access the S-AEIS-IS?

International students can access the system through the International Students Admissions website at <https://www.moe.gov.sg/international-students>. Access to the S-AEIS-IS will only be available during the stipulated period as stated at Q4.

Q6. Do I need to make any payment for using the S-AEIS-IS?

Q8. What do I need to have ready before logging on to the S-AEIS-IS to access the outcome of my application for school admission via the S-AEIS?

You are required to have the following ready:

- (a) Computer with Internet access
- (b) Applicant's Passport Number / Foreign Identification Number (FIN)
- (c) Applicant's Date of Birth

Q9. Will I be automatically logged out if I stayed too long on a particular page?

Yes. Applicants with no activity on the S-AEIS-IS web page for more than 10 minutes will automatically be logged out by the system so as to ensure that other applicants can enjoy a speedy and smooth access to the S-AEIS-IS.

Q10. What are the options for international students who are unsuccessful in the S-AEIS?

Applicants are strongly encouraged to prepare themselves before sitting for the S-AEIS tests and they should be familiar with the syllabus of the level preceding the one they are applying for.

Applicants who have taken part in the S-AEIS and are unsuccessful may apply to take subsequent AEIS / S-AEIS, provided they meet the permissible age range.

Q11. How do I print the outcome of my application for school admission under the S-AEIS?

You may print the outcome by clicking on the Print button or the "Print This Page" icon on the web page. Alternatively, you may also use the "Ctrl+P" or "File->Print" function on your browser.

Q12. Why was the error message "Date of Birth is invalid" displayed when I tried to login to the S-AEIS-IS?

You have entered the Date of Birth in the wrong format. Please check you have entered in DD/MM/YYYY format, for example, 25/02/2009 for applicants born on 25 Feb 2009.
